Kendo UI Builder by Progress: OpenEdge Edition Installation

The Kendo UI® Builder by Progress® (Kendo UI Builder) must be used with OpenEdge 11.6.3 or later. When you install Kendo UI Builder, Node.js 4.2.6, the open-source, cross-platform runtime environment for developing server-side Web applications, is also installed if you do not already have it.

Prerequisites

System requirements:

- Windows 64-bit.
- OpenEdge 11.6.3 or a later.

Installing Kendo UI Builder

Caution: Stop any running instance of Progress Application Server for OpenEdge before installing Kendo UI Builder. The installation process stops all such instances by default, so you may lose data.

To install Kendo UI Builder:

1. Double-click the `KendoUIBuilderForOE.exe` file. The **Kendo UI Builder for OpenEdge InstallShield Wizard** appears.

Note: An error message is displayed if you do not have OpenEdge 11.6.3 or later installed.

2. Click **Next**.
3. Enter the serial number and the control code. Click **Next**.
4. Click **Change** if you want to update the default destination folder where Kendo UI Builder will be installed. The default location is `C:\Progress\KendoUIBuilder`. Click **Next**.
5. To begin installation, click **Install**.

Note: You can click **Back** if you want to review or update any installation settings. Also, if Node.js is not already installed, it is installed with Kendo UI Builder installation.

6. Click **Finish** when the installation is complete.

Note: If the installation fails, you can check the `KendoUIBuilderOEInstall.log` file located in the `%TEMP%` folder for details.

Uninstalling Kendo UI Builder

If you want to uninstall Kendo UI Builder, do one the following:

- Run the `KendoUIBuilderForOE.exe` file (that you used for installation) again and click **Remove**.
- Open **Control Panel > Programs and Features**, right-click **Kendo UI Builder for OpenEdge**, and click **Uninstall**.

Note: Uninstalling Kendo UI Builder does not uninstall Node.js. even if it was installed with Kendo UI Builder uninstallation if it is running for any other program.
