Kendo UI Builder by Progress: OpenEdge Edition Installation

When you install Kendo UI Builder, Nodejs 6.10.2, the open-source, cross-platform runtime environment for developing server-side Web applications, is also installed if you do not already have it.

Note: Kendo UI Builder supports Nodejs 4.x and above.

Prerequisites

System requirements:

- Windows 64-bit.

Installing Kendo UI Builder

To install Kendo UI Builder:

1. Double-click the `KendoUIBuilderForOE.exe` file. The **Kendo UI Builder for OpenEdge InstallShield Wizard** appears.
2. Click **Next**.
3. Enter the serial number and the control code. Click **Next**.
4. Click **Change** if you want to update the default destination folder where Kendo UI Builder will be installed. The default location is `C:\Progress\KendoUIBuilder`. Click **Next**.
5. To begin installation, click **Install**.

Note: You can click **Back** if you want to review or update any installation settings. Also, if Nodejs is not already installed, it is installed with Kendo UI Builder installation.

6. Click **Finish** when the installation is complete.

Note: If the installation fails, you can check the `KendoUIBuilderOEInstall.log` file located in the `%TEMP%` folder for details.

Uninstalling Kendo UI Builder

If you want to uninstall Kendo UI Builder, do one the following:

- Run the `KendoUIBuilderForOE.exe` file (that you used for installation) again and click **Remove**.
- Open **Control Panel > Programs and Features**, right-click **Kendo UI Builder for OpenEdge**, and click **Uninstall**.

Note:

When you uninstall Kendo UI Builder, Node.js does not get uninstalled.

Prior to Kendo UI Builder 2.0 version, the `workspace.json` file was placed in the Kendo UI Builder installation directory. Now, you can find the file in the `%appdata%\KendoUIBuilder\workspaces.json` location.
